



**Garbage**

Black Cart garbage pickup is now bi-weekly, every other Wednesday. The cart provided was chosen for its durability and its ease of use. It holds three times as much as a normal trash can. The cart’s large wheels, makes it easy to maneuver, and it completely eliminates the lifting of heavy cans. Carts need to be placed roadside by 7:00 am on collection day. ***Black Cart Pickup*** dates are as follows:

The Transfer Station is a collection depot available to the residents of Langham and the RM of Corman Park for garbage that will be transferred to the Northern Landfill. There are specific areas available for old wood items, concrete, white metal, composting of leaves and grass, and bins for other household garbage. Items must be sorted and disposed of in the appropriate places.

To deposit old shingles at the Transfer Station, a shingle permit must be purchased at the Town Office at a cost of \$1 for every 16 square feet of shingles removed. If there are two layers of shingles removed, then the cost is doubled and so on.

Hazardous wastes including tires, oil, oil cans, or chemicals are NOT allowed into the transfer station. These must be recycled through authorized dealers.
